**AN ACT to amend the Public Institutions and Friendly
Societies Lands Improvement Act, 1892.**

[Assented to 15th December, 1923.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Public Institutions and Friendly Societies Lands Improvement Act Amendment Act, 1923.* Short title.

2. Section two of the Public Institutions and Friendly Societies Lands Improvement Act, 1892, is hereby amended, Amendment of Section 2. by the addition of the following words, that is to say:—

“and the word ‘institution’ shall also include any Trade Union and Trades and Labour Council and any Association in which, or in any trustees for which, any Trades Hall or land acquired or held for the purpose of a Trades Hall is vested.”

3. Section three of the Public Institutions and Friendly Societies Lands Improvement Act, 1892, is amended by inserting the words “an institution or” before the words “the duly appointed trustees”; and section five of the said Act is amended by inserting the words “an institution or” before the words “the trustees.” Amendment of Section 3 and 5
