No. 7 of 1924.**AN ACT to amend the Trade Unions Act, 1902.**

[Assented to 5th November, 1924.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Trade Unions Act Amendment Act, 1924.* Short title.

2. The interpretation of the term "Registrar" in section two of the Trade Unions Act, 1902, is hereby amended by omitting the words "the Registrar of Friendly Societies appointed under the Friendly Societies Act, 1894," and inserting in place thereof "the Registrar of Industrial Unions appointed under the Industrial Arbitration Act, 1912."
