AN ACT to further amend the Treasury Bills Act, 1893.

[Assented to 18th December, 1924.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Treasury Bills Act Amendment Act, 1924.*

2. Section four of the Act number two of the fifty-seventh year of the reign of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, is hereby amended by omitting the words "five pounds per centum" and inserting "six pounds per centum" in lieu thereof.
