No. 56 of 1923.**AN ACT to amend the Law with respect to Disqualifications on account of Sex.**

[Assented to 22nd December, 1923.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Women's Legal Status Act, 1923.* Short title.

2. A person shall not be disqualified by sex from the exercise of any public function, or from being appointed to or holding any civil or judicial office or post, or from being admitted and entitled to practise as a practitioner within the meaning of that term in the Legal Practitioners Act, 1893, or from entering or assuming or carrying on any other profession, any law or usage to the contrary notwithstanding.
