AN ACT to further amend the Workers' Homes Act, 1911.

[Assented to 31st December, 1925.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Workers' Homes Act Amendment Act, 1925*, and shall be read as one with the Workers' Homes Act, 1911, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. Section eight of the principal Act is amended by deleting the proviso to the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the words "Provided that the cost of such erection or construction, including sewerage connections, shall not in the case of any dwelling-house exceed six hundred and fifty pounds." Amendment of Sec. 8.

3. The proviso to subsection (1) of section twenty-four of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words "five hundred and fifty pounds," and inserting in place thereof "six hundred and fifty pounds, inclusive of the cost of sewerage connections." Amendment of Sec. 24.
