

## BAYSWATER DRAINAGE.

11° GEO. V., No. XXIX.

No. 29 of 1920.

**AN ACT to enable the Bayswater Road Board to borrow money for the payment of Compensation in respect of certain Drainage Works in the Bayswater Road District.**

[Assented to 31st December, 1920.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Bayswater Drainage Works Act, 1920.* Short title.

2. It shall be lawful for the Bayswater Road Board, under and subject to Part VII. of the Road Districts Act, 1919, to borrow such sum of money as may be necessary and the Minister may approve, to enable the Board to pay to the owners and occupiers of land within the Bayswater Road District such compensation and costs as may be or become due to them in respect of the damage sustained by them through the construction by the said Board of certain drainage works known as the Lawrence Street drain; and to defray the costs incurred by the said Board in the legal proceedings relating to such drains. Power to borrow.
