# PERMANENT RESERVES.

#### 12° GEO. V., No. XL.

## No. 6 of 1922.

## AN ACT to enable the Purpose of portions of certain Reserves to be changed.

### [Assented to 31st January, 1922.]

**B** E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

Power to excise portion of Reserve A ∧10705.

Power to excise portions of Reserves  $\Lambda \ \Lambda 15677$  and  $\Lambda \ \Lambda 13873$ .

Power to lease portion of Reserve A A4991.

Portion of A #4228 excised and vested in Municipality. 1. This Act may be cited as the *Permanent Reserves Act*, 1921.

2. That portion of reserve A  $\Lambda$ 10705 known as Pingelly Lot 135 is excised from the said reserve, to the intent that it may be made available for the purpose of a Soldiers' Memorial Park.

3. Those portions of reserve  $A \wedge 15677$  as described in Part I. of the schedule hereto are excised from the said reserve, and that portion of reserve  $A \wedge 13873$  described in Part. II. of the schedule hereto is excised from the said reserve, to the intent that the same may be disposed of under the provisions of the Land Act, 1898.

4. It shall be lawful for the Bunbury Municipal Council, with the approval of the Governor, to lease a portion or portions of reserve  $A \wedge 4991$ , not exceeding in the aggregate one acre, for the purpose of public refreshment rooms.

5. That portion of  $A \wedge 4228$  adjacent to the Electric Light Station at Claremont, bounded by lines starting from the North-East corner of Swan Location 2112, and extending Northward along the Western side of Davies Road, for a distance of 2 chains 41 7/10 links; thence 270deg. 12min., about 1922.]

#### Permanent Reserves.

5 chains, to the North-East corner of Reserve 9249 (Location 2032); thence Southward along the latter's Eastern boundary to the Northern side of Shenton Road; thence along the latter 90deg 16min., 163 8/10 links; thence 0deg. 12min., 488 4/10 links, to the North boundary of Location 2511, and thence along the latter and that of Location 2112 aforesaid 90deg. 12min. to the starting point. (Area, about 2 acres, is excised from the said reserve.)

#### SCHEDULE.

Section 3.

#### PART I.

(1.) An area of about 170 acres, being part of Hay Location 1037, Reserve A  $\land$  15677, and bounded by lines starting at a point bearing 134deg. 45min. and distant 141.4 links from the South-West corner of Hay Location 1008, and extending 89deg. 45min., 3,998 links; thence 179deg. 51min., 2,116 links; thence 179deg. 48min., 1,395 links; thence 256deg. 23min., 2,212 links; thence 359deg. 47min. 1,000 links; thence 269deg. 47min. about 3,438 links; thence 359deg. 47min., about 2,074 links; thence 89deg. 46min., about 1,594 links, and thence 359deg. 45min., 947.9 links to the starting point.

(2.) Also part of same reserve: An area of about 96 acres, and bounded by lines starting from the North-West corner of Hay Location 591, and extending 359deg. 51min., about 1,980 links; thence 89deg. 47min., about 4,840 links, to a North-West corner of Hay Location 471; thence 179deg. 47min., 1,980 links, to the North-East corner of Hay Location 591 aforesaid, and thence 269deg. 47min., 4,842 links, to the starting point.

#### PART II.

An area comprising about 880,000 acres, being part of Reserve A  $\land$  13873, and bounded by lines starting from a point situate East about 610 chains and South 160 chains from the South-East corner of the Forrest River Mission Reserve 3960, and extending South to the Western bank of the West arm of Cambridge Gulf; thence along the said bank and that of

the Pentecost River to a point opposite Survey Mark  $\stackrel{\frown}{\operatorname{HB}}$ ; thence West to the summit of Mount Edith; thence Westward to the summit of Mount Dorothy; thence North to a point West of the starting point, and thence East to the starting point.
