AN ACT to amend Section Six of the Public Service Act,
1904.

[Assented to 31st December, 1920.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Public Service Act Amendment Act*, 1920, and shall be read as one with the Public Service Act, 1904, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. Subsection (5) of section six of the principal Act is hereby amended, by omitting the words "eight hundred and fifty pounds," and inserting the words "one thousand pounds" in place thereof. Amendment section 6.

Such amendment shall have effect as from the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty.
