AN ACT to amend the War Council Act, 1915, and to ratify the distribution of certain Funds of the W.A. Central Sand-bag Committee.

[Assented to 7th August, 1917.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *War Council Act Amendment Act, 1917.*

Short title.

2. The allocation by the W.A. Central Sand-bag Committee, pursuant to a resolution passed on the thirteenth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and seventeen, to the War Patriotic Fund, the Victoria League (Trench Comfort Funds of Western Australian Battalions), and the Red Cross Society (Amelioration Fund), of the moneys then in the hands of the said committee, and the payments made in accordance therewith, are hereby ratified, and the said Committee and the members thereof are hereby released and discharged from all trusts and obligations relating to the said moneys.
