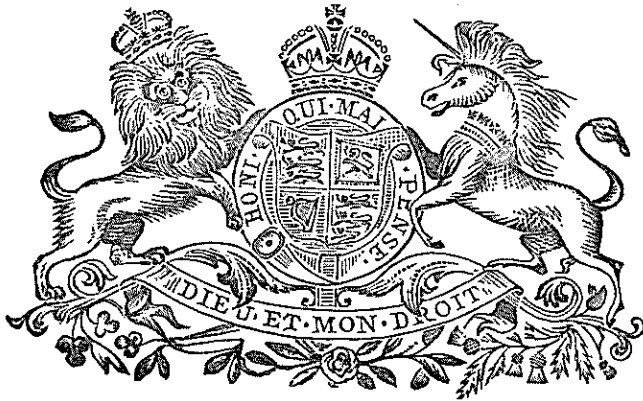

AN ACT to amend the Transfer of Land Act, 1893.

[Assented to 11th December, 1917.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Transfer of Land Act Amendment Act, 1917*, and shall be read as one with the Transfer of Land Act, 1893, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. Section forty-nine of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "Every duplicate or special certificate of title hereafter to be issued shall be on parchment." Amendment of Section 49.
