AN ACT to continue the operation of the Sale  
of Liquor Regulation Act, 1915.

[Assented to 11th December, 1917.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by  
and with the advice and consent of the Legislative  
Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in  
this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of  
the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Sale of Liquor Regulation Act* Short title.  
*Act Continuation Act*, 1917.

2. The Sale of Liquor Regulation Act, 1915, shall continue Continuation of Act  
in operation until the thirty-first day of December, one thousand  
nine hundred and eighteen, but no longer.
