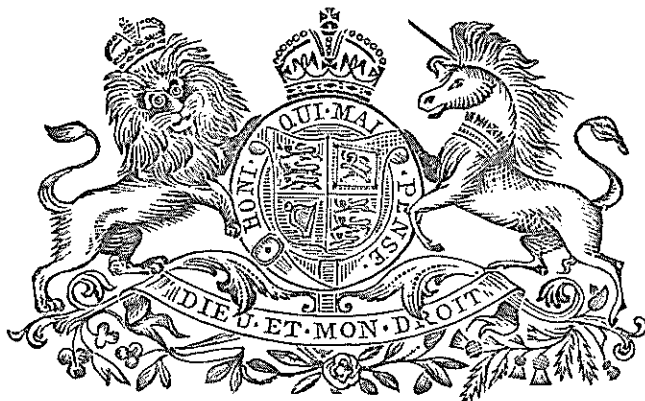

AN ACT for the Closing of certain Roads.

[Assented to 4th October, 1913.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Roads Closure Act, 1913.*

Short title.

2. All rights-of-way on and over the roads described in the Schedule to this Act shall cease from the passing of this Act, and His Majesty may deal with such roads as if the same had never been subject to such rights.

Closure of certain roads.

**THE SCHEDULE.**

The surveyed road passing along the South-Eastern and South-Western boundaries of Subdivisional Lot 140 of Leschenault Location 9.

The surveyed road passing along the South-Eastern and South boundaries of Subdivisional Lot 50 of Leschenault Location 9.

The surveyed road passing along the East boundaries of Subdivisional Lots 55 to 59 inclusive, and 114, 115, and 118 of Leschenault Location 9.

The said roads being delineated on Titles Office Plans 2842 and 2843.
