AN ACT to further amend the Perth Mint Act, 1895.

[Assented to 26th November, 1919.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Perth Mint Act Amendment Act, 1919*.

Amendment
of s. 2.

2. Section two of the Perth Mint Act, 1895, as amended by the Perth Mint Amendment Act, 1905, is hereby further amended by striking out the words "twenty-two thousand five hundred pounds," and inserting in place thereof "twenty-five thousand pounds."
