AN ACT to enable the purpose of Reserve A^12391 and of portion of Reserve A^9337 to be changed.

[Assented to 17th March, 1915.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Permanent Reserves Act, 1915*. Short title.

2. That portion of Reserve A^9337 adjacent to Reserve A^9338, having a frontage of 235 links to Subiaco Road and a frontage of 235 links to Mueller Road and a depth of 901.6 links, is excised therefrom, and may be reclassified either as of Class A or Class B, and dedicated to such public purpose as to the Governor may seem fit

Power to excise portion of Reserve A^9337.

3. (1.) It shall be lawful for the West Australian Conference of Seventh Day Adventists, Incorporated, to surrender to the Crown its lease of Reserve A ^ 12391 (Subiaco) on the demise by the Crown of other land in exchange.

Power to change the purpose of Reserve A ^ 12391.

(2.) On the said reserve being surrendered as aforesaid, it shall cease to be dedicated to the purpose of a Church for the Seventh Day Adventists and may be reclassified as of Class A or Class B and dedicated to such public purpose as to the Governor may seem fit.
