AN ACT to change the purpose of certain Permanent Reserves.

[Assented to 30th December, 1913.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Permanent Reserves Act*, Short title. 1913.

2. The purpose of the Reserve $\frac{AA}{No. 9286}$ (Kalgoorlie Town Lots 2569 and 2767) is hereby changed from park lands and drainage to the purpose of water supply, and the land therein comprised is hereby vested for an estate in fee simple in the Hon. Minister for Water Supply, Sewerage, and Drainage. Change of purpose of Reserve $\frac{AA}{9286}$.

3. That portion of Reserve $\frac{AA}{No. 2101}$ (park lands) at Greenmount, containing 16 acres 2 roods 30 perches, as surveyed and delineated on diagram 1394 in the Department of Lands and Surveys, and known as Swan Location 2693, is excised from the said reserve, and may be set apart for the purpose of a gravel quarry for the Midland Junction Municipality. 4. That portion of Reserve $\frac{A.A.}{No. 8427}$, near Yallingup, containing about two acres, and bounded by lines starting from a point situate 3 chains $54\frac{1}{2}$ links South and 8 chains 70 links East from the South-East corner of Sussex Location 360, and extending $107^{\circ} 21'$ 4 chains $46\frac{8}{10}$ links and $78^{\circ} 18' 85\frac{8}{10}$ links along a public road from Yallingup to Busselton; thence South 4 chains $26\frac{1}{2}$ links; thence West 3 chains $70\frac{8}{10}$ links, and thence $345^{\circ} 33'$ 5 chains 60 links along a public road from the Margaret to Yallingup to the starting point, is excised from the said reserve and may be set apart for the purposes of an agricultural hall and church sites.
