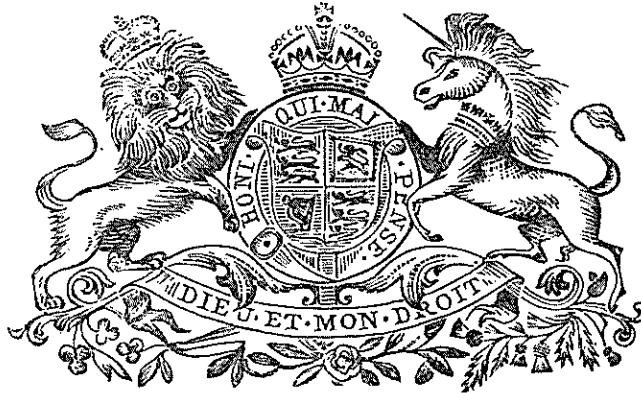

AN ACT to authorise the granting of Mineral Leases on Reserve $\frac{A\Lambda}{7537}$.

[Assented to 17th November, 1916.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Permanent Reserve Act*, 1916. Short title.

2. It shall be lawful for the Governor to grant, under the provisions of Division (3) of Part V. of the Mining Act, 1904, a Mineral Lease of any portion of the permanent Reserve $\frac{A\Lambda}{7537}$ (National Park). Power to grant Mineral Lease of portion of Reserve.
