AN ACT to amend the Melville Tramways Act, 1914.

[Assented to 7th August, 1917.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Melville Tramways Act Amendment Act, 1917*, and shall be read as one with the Melville Tramways Act, 1914, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. Section three of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "two years" in the second paragraph of subsection (1) thereof, and inserting "seven years" in place thereof. Amendment of Section 3.
