AN ACT to continue the operation of the Licensing Act Amendment Act, 1914, until the thirty-first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and fifteen.

[Assented to 18th February, 1915.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Licensing Act Amendment Continuance Act, 1915*. Short title.

2. The Licensing Act Amendment Act, 1914, shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and fifteen, but no longer. Continuance of Act No. 22 of 1914.
