AN ACT to transfer to the Colonial Treasurer, on the expiration of the Grain and Foodstuff Act, 1914, the assets and liabilities of the Board created under the said Act.

[Assented to 14th October, 1915.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Grain and Foodstuff Act, 1915*. Short title.

2. On the expiration by effluxion of time of the Grain and Foodstuff Act, 1914, the property, including all rights, contracts, choses in action, and causes of action, vested in the Board constituted under the said Act shall vest in and be held and may be recovered and enforced by the Colonial Treasurer, and all the debts and liabilities of the said Board shall become the debts and liabilities of the Colonial Treasurer and shall be recoverable and enforceable against the Colonial Treasurer accordingly, and all pending actions (if any) by or against the Board may be continued by or against the Colonial Treasurer in the name of his office as plaintiff or defendant as the case may be.
