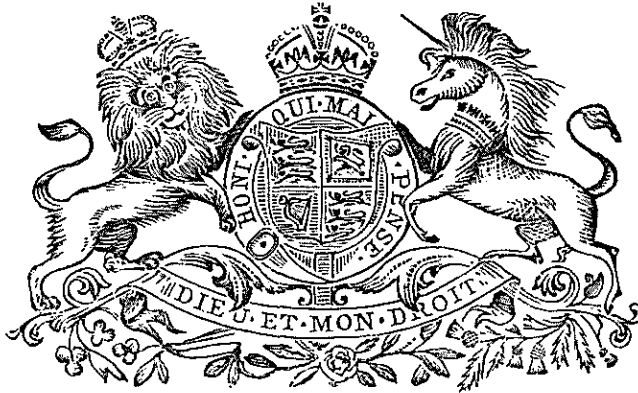

AN ACT to amend the Early Closing Act, 1902, and its amendments.

[Assented to 23rd March, 1917.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Early Closing Act Amendment Act, 1917*, and shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Proclamation. Short title and commencement.

2. In this Act the expression "Early Closing Act" means the Early Closing Act, 1902, and its amendments as reprinted in the 1911-12 Sessional Volume of the Western Australian Statutes. Interpretation.

3. The following proviso is hereby added to section eleven of the Early Closing Act, that is to say:— Amendment of Section 11 of Early Closing Act.

"Provided that the foregoing provisions of this section shall, whilst such resolution as is set out in Schedule Four is in force in any district, be read and have effect in such district as if 'Friday' were substituted for 'Saturday' and 'Saturday' for 'Wednesday' in and throughout such provisions."
