AN ACT to amend the Adoption of Children Act, 1896.

[Assented to 13th September, 1915.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Adoption of Children Act Amendment Act, 1915*, and shall be read as one with the Adoption of Children Act, 1896, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Short title.

2. Section two of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "adoption," in the interpretation of "adopted child," the following words:—"has been made as herein provided; and 'adopting parent' means any person who is by any such order of adoption."

Amendment of Section 2.

3. All copies of the principal Act hereafter printed by the Government Printer shall be printed as amended by this Act, under the supervision of the Clerk of Parliaments, and a reference to this Act shall be made in the margin.
