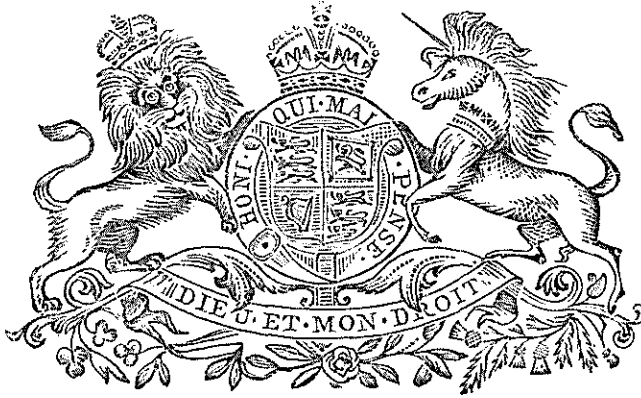

AN ACT to enable the purpose of portion of Permanent Reserve numbered  $\frac{A\wedge}{4991}$  to be changed.

[Assented to 19th January, 1911.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. All that piece or parcel of land described in the Schedule hereto, being a portion of the permanent reserve at Bunbury numbered  $\frac{A\wedge}{4991}$ , is hereby excised from the said reserve, and is constituted a public reserve and numbered  $\frac{A\wedge}{13077}$ , and is dedicated to the purpose of a site for the Eastern Goldfields Fresh Air League Institution.

THE SCHEDULE.

That piece or parcel of land known as Bunbury Town Lot 366, containing about one acre and three-quarters, the South-East corner thereof being the intersection of the West side of Malcolm Street and the North side of Carey Street, and the East boundary extending North along the said West side of Malcolm Street for a distance of three chains ten links, and the South boundary extending West along the said North side of Carey Street.
