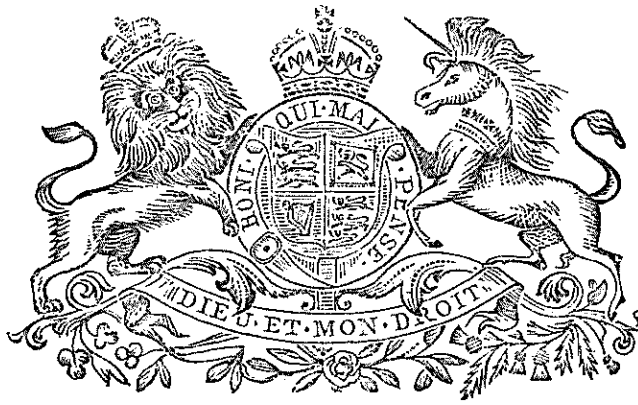

AN ACT to amend the North Fremantle Municipal Tramways Act, 1907.

[Assented to 19th August, 1912.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *North Fremantle Municipal Tramways Act Amendment Act, 1912.* Short title.

2. The following subsection is hereby added to section seven of the North Fremantle Municipal Tramways Act, 1907, as from the commencement thereof:— Amendment of section 7.

(3.) If the Council has heretofore expended or shall hereafter expend out of the Municipal Fund of the Council any moneys for any purpose for which moneys may be borrowed under this Act, the Council shall be entitled to be reimbursed out of moneys so borrowed or to be borrowed, and may take out of any such moneys an amount equal to the amount so expended, and may use such amount as moneys belonging to the said Municipal Fund. Council to be entitled to reimbursement out of moneys borrowed.
