AN ACT to amend the Kalgoorlie and Boulder
Racing Clubs Act, 1904.

[Assented to 24th December, 1912.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Kalgoorlie and Boulder Racing Clubs Act Amendment Act, 1912.* Short title.
2. Section thirty-eight of the Kalgoorlie and Boulder Racing Clubs Act, 1904 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), is amended by omitting the words "the thirtieth day of April in the year preceding," in the second and third lines thereof, and by inserting in place thereof "a date in each year to be fixed from time to time by the by-laws of the Club"; and by omitting the words "the thirtieth day of April," in the sixth line thereof, and inserting in place thereof "such date." Amendment of sec. 38.
3. Section thirty-nine of the principal Act is amended by omitting the words "on or before the first day of June in each year," and inserting in place thereof "in each year within thirty days after the date upon which the books of the Club are balanced." Amendment of sec. 39.
