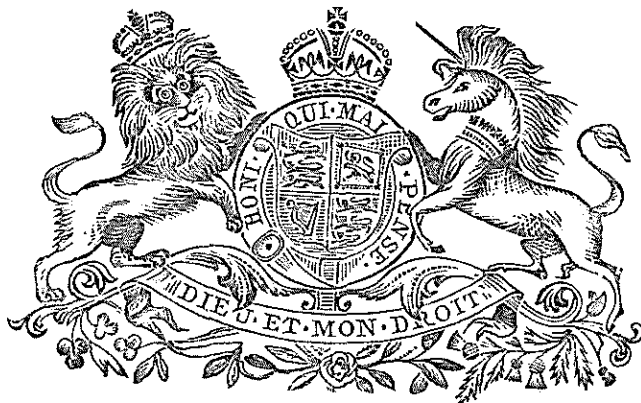

AN ACT to amend the Electoral Act, 1907.

[Assented to 30th December, 1912.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Electoral Act Amendment Act, 1912*, and shall be read as one with the Electoral Act, 1907, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. Subsection two of section twenty-four of the principal Act, as amended by section nine of the Electoral Act Amendment Act, 1911, is amended by omitting the words "once in every year," and inserting in place thereof "once at least in every three years." Provided that rolls in an amalgamated form for the Legislative Council shall be printed and issued during the month of February in each year in which an ordinary election for the Legislative Council is to be held. Amendment of section 24.

3. Section ten of the Electoral Act Amendment Act, 1911, is hereby repealed, and subsection (a.) of section twenty-six of the Electoral Act, 1907, as follows:— Re-enactment of subsection (a) of section 26 of 7 Edward VII., No. 27.

(a) As soon after the last day of March, June, September, and December in each year as practicable, and not later than the last day of the month next following; and is hereby re-enacted.
