AN ACT to authorise the Establishment and Maintenance of a State Hotel at Dwellingup.

[Assented to 31st December, 1911.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Dwellingup State Hotel Act*, Short title. 1911.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Licensing Act, 1911, to the contrary, it shall be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer,—

Power to establish a State Hotel at Dwellingup.

- (a.) to establish a State Hotel at Dwellingup. in the Forrest Licensing District; and
- (b.) to carry on by his authorised agent, in such State Hotel. the trade and business of a person holding a publican's general license.
