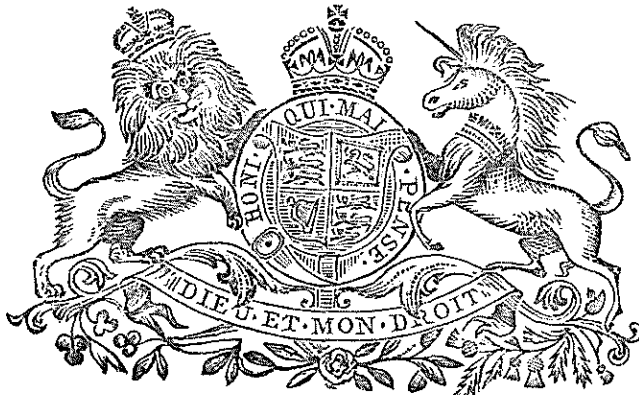

AN ACT to amend the District Fire Brigades Act, 1909.

[Assented to 24th December, 1912.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *District Fire Brigades Act* Short title. *Amendment Act, 1912.*

2. Any local authority which has heretofore made, levied, or collected any additional rate or increased its general rate above the statutory limit for the purpose of providing the amount or any portion of the amount of any contribution payable by such authority under the District Fire Brigades Act, 1909, shall be deemed to have had power so to do, and its action is hereby validated accordingly, and such additional rate or increase of general rates may be collected, recovered, and got in in the same way as general rates made by such local authority.
