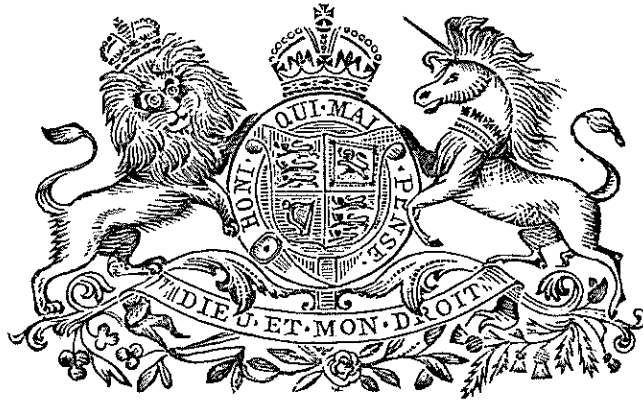

AN ACT to apply from the Loan Suspense Account the sum of Forty Thousand Pounds for the construction of the Southern Cross-Bullfinch Railway.

[Assented to 22nd December, 1910.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. There shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the construction of the Southern Cross-Bullfinch Railway the sum of Forty thousand pounds from the Loan Suspense Account, and the Colonial Treasurer of Western Australia is hereby authorised and empowered to issue and apply such sum accordingly. Issue and application of £40,000.

2. The said sum shall be available to satisfy the warrants under the hands of the Governor for the service aforesaid. Sum available.
