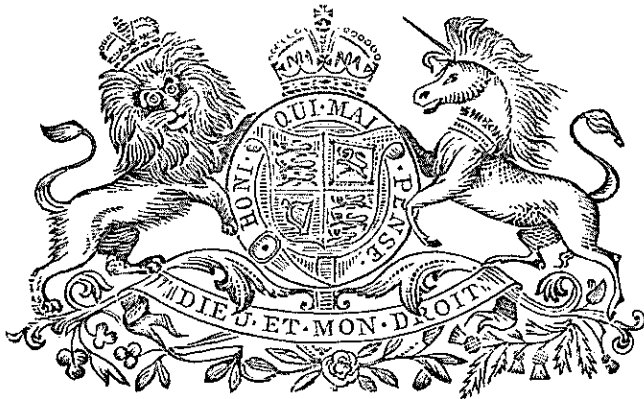

AN ACT to further amend the Agricultural Bank Act, 1906.

[Assented to 22nd November, 1910.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Agricultural Bank Act Amendment Act, 1910*, and shall be read as one with the Agricultural Bank Act, 1906, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. Section sixteen of the principal Act as amended by section three of the Agricultural Bank Act Amendment Act, 1909, is further amended by striking out the words "two million pounds" and inserting in place thereof the words "two million five hundred thousand pounds." Amendment of 1906, No. 15, s. 16.

3. Section twenty-eight of the principal Act, as amended by section four of the Agricultural Bank Act Amendment Act, 1909, is hereby amended by striking out the words "and (d.)" in sub-section six. Amendment of 1906, No. 15, s. 28.
