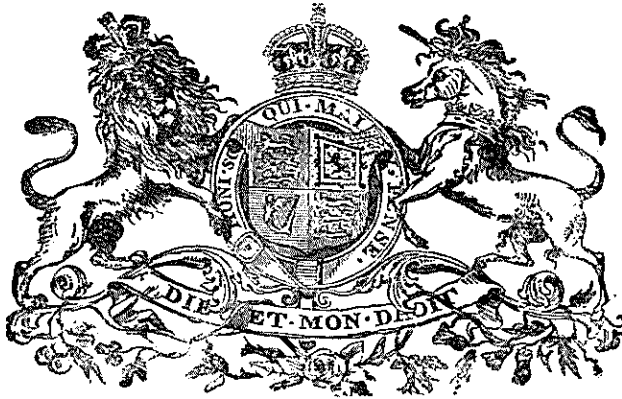

AN ACT to enable the purpose of Reserve,  
York Town Lot 211, to be changed.

[Assented to 6th February, 1909.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Reserve known as York Town Lot 211 vested by Crown Grant dated the 27th day of December, 1883, in the Council and Burgesses of the Town of York upon trust for the recreation of the inhabitants of the said Town, shall henceforth be held by the Municipality of York in trust for municipal purposes generally.
