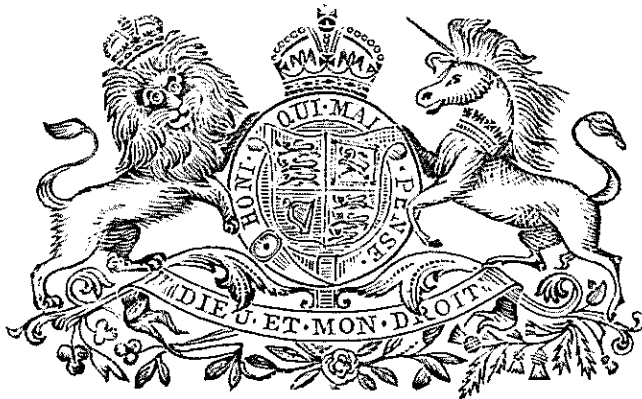

AN ACT to change the purpose of certain  
Permanent Reserves.

[Assented to 20th November, 1909.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. Reserve numbered <sup>AA</sup>10858, situated in the Municipal District of Subiaco, and now dedicated to the purposes of the Seventh Day Adventists, shall cease to be so dedicated, and shall henceforth be dedicated to the purposes of the Perth Children's Hospital. Change of purpose of Reserve <sup>AA</sup>10858.

2. That portion of permanent Reserve <sup>AA</sup>3078, situated in the Municipal District of Subiaco, and particularly described in the First Schedule, is hereby excised from the said reserve and included in reserve numbered <sup>AA</sup>6052, and dedicated to the purpose of the Perth Children's Hospital. Change of purpose of portion of Reserve <sup>AA</sup>3078.

3. That portion of permanent Reserve <sup>AA</sup>3078, situate in the Municipal District of Subiaco, and particularly described in the Second Schedule, is hereby excised from the said reserve, and included in reserve numbered <sup>AA</sup>6052, and dedicated to the purpose of the Perth Children's Hospital. 4. That portion of permanent Reserve <sup>AA</sup>3078, situated in the Municipal District of Subiaco, and particularly described in the Third Schedule, now dedicated to the purpose of public buildings, is hereby excised from the said reserve, and is constituted Reserve <sup>AA</sup>12391, and dedicated to the purpose of a church for the Seventh Day Adventists.

SCHEDULES.

---

First Schedule.

All that portion of permanent Reserve <sup>AA</sup>3078, containing about 1 rood 3 perches, and bounded on the North-East by the South-Western boundary of Perth Suburban Lot 463; on the South-East by about 2 chains  $35\frac{2}{10}$  links of the North-Western side of Thomas Street; and on the West by the East boundary of Perth Suburban Lot 466.

Second Schedule.

All that portion of permanent Reserve <sup>AA</sup>3078, containing about  $9\frac{2}{10}$  perches, bounded on the North by part of the Southern boundary of Perth Suburban Lot 185; on the South by about  $15\frac{2}{10}$  links of the Northern side of Hay Street; on the East by the Western boundary of Perth Suburban Lot 466; and on the West by a line parallel to the Eastern boundary and  $15\frac{2}{10}$  links therefrom.

Third Schedule.

All that portion of Reserve <sup>AA</sup>3078, bounded on the North by about  $80\frac{2}{10}$  links of part of the Southern boundary of Perth Suburban Lot 185; on the South by about  $80\frac{2}{10}$  links of the Northern side of Hay Street; on the West by the Eastern boundary of Perth Suburban Lot 405; and on the East by a line parallel to the Western boundary and  $80\frac{2}{10}$  links therefrom.
