AN ACT to further amend the Perth Mint Act, 1895.

[Assented to 14th December, 1905.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Perth Mint Amendment Act, 1905*, and shall come into operation on the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and six. Short title and commencement.

2. Section two of the Perth Mint Act, 1895, as amended by the Act passed in the sixty-third year of Her late Majesty and numbered two, is hereby further amended by striking out the words "twenty thousand pounds" and inserting in place thereof "twenty-two thousand five hundred pounds."
