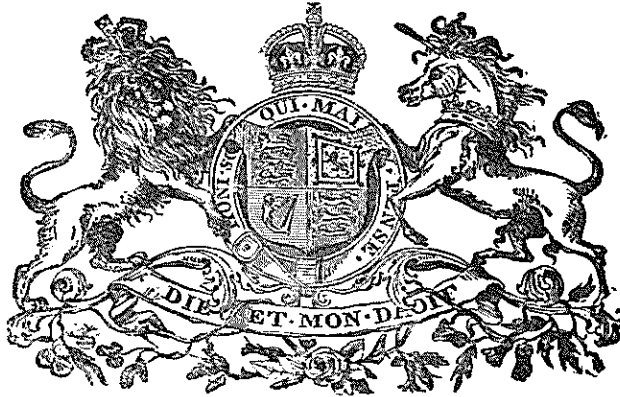

AN ACT to further amend the Agricultural Bank Act, 1894.

[Assented to 23rd December, 1905.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Agricultural Bank Act* Short title. *Amendment Act, 1905*, and shall be read as one with the Agricultural Bank Act, 1894, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

2. The amount which the Colonial Treasurer is authorised by section five of the principal Act to raise for the purposes of the Act by the issue of mortgage bonds, as therein provided, is increased to a sum not exceeding in the aggregate Six hundred thousand pounds.
