AN ACT to amend the Perth Mint Act, 1895.

[Assented to, 2nd August, 1899.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. THE Perth Mint Act, 1895, is hereby amended by striking out the word "Ten," in the third line of the second section, and substituting the word "Twenty."
