AN ACT to amend the Law relating to Bills of Sale, Liens, and Bailments.

[Assented to, 5th December, 1900.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. THIS Act may be cited as the Bills of Sale Act Amendment Act, 1900, and shall be incorporated with and form part of the Bills of Sale Act, 1899. Short title.

2. THE fifty-fourth section of the Bills of Sale Act, 1899, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "piano," the words "musical instruments," "bicycle," "cash registers," "billiard tables and accessories," "agricultural machinery and implements." Amendment of section 54 of principal Act.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
