AN ACT to amend the Police Act, 1892.

[Assented to, 28th October, 1898.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. THIS Act may be cited as the Police Act Amendment Act, 1898.

Short title.

2. SECTION two of the Police Act, 1892, Amendment Act, 1894 (No. 2), shall be and the same is hereby repealed.

Repeal of Section 2 of 58 Vic., No. 26.

3. EVERY member of the police force may prosecute for any breach of or offence against any by-law or regulation made by any Municipality, Roads Board, or Board of Health.

Power to prosecute for breach of by-laws

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
