AN ACT to amend the Metropolitan Water Works Act, 1896.

[Assented to, 28th October, 1898.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to increase the Borrowing Powers of the Metropolitan Water Works Board, for the purpose of improving the Water Supply of the City of Perth: Be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. THIS Act may be cited as the Metropolitan Water Works Act, 1896, Amendment Act, 1898.

Short title.

2. THE Board may issue debentures to the extent of Four hundred thousand pounds, instead of Three hundred and fifty thousand pounds as provided by Section 13 of the Metropolitan

Borrowing power of Board increased to £400,000.

3. NO portion of the moneys raised under the powers conferred by this Act shall be expended by the Board without the approval of the Governor.
