AN ACT to amend the Bush Fires Act,
1885.

[Assented to, 28th October, 1898.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend the Law relating to Bush Fires: Be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. THIS Act may be cited for all purposes as the Bush Fires Act, 1885, Amendment Act, 1898.

Short Title.

2. SECTION seven of the Bush Fires Act, 1885, is hereby amended by omitting all the words after the word "pounds" in the fifth line thereof.

Amendment of Sec. 7 of 49 Vict., No. 9.

3. SECTIONS eight and nine of the Bush Fires Act, 1885, are hereby repealed.

Repeal of Secs. 8 and 9 of 49 Vict., No. 9.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
