AN ACT to amend the Medical Act, 1894.

[Assented to, 11th September, 1895.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. THIS Act may be cited as "The Medical Act Amendment Act, 1895," and shall be read and construed together with "The Medical Act, 1894."

Short title and construction.

2. PARAGRAPH Ten of the Second Schedule of the said Act is hereby amended by striking out the words "or Colonial University," and substituting in lieu thereof the words "or legally constituted and recognised Australian, Tasmanian, or New Zealand University."

Amendment of paragraph 10 of Second Schedule of principal Act.

3. PARAGRAPH Thirteen of the said Second Schedule is hereby repealed.

Repeal of paragraph thirteen of Second Schedule of principal Act.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
