An Act to authorise the Closing of Portions of certain
Streets and Thoroughfares in the Town of Bunbury.

[Assented to 28th November, 1894.]

WHEREAS certain pieces of land in the Town of Bunbury, ^{Preamble}
more particularly described in the Schedule hereto, have
hitherto formed portions of certain Public Streets and Thoroughfares :
And whereas it is expedient that all Rights of Way in and over the
said pieces of land should cease: Be it therefore enacted by the
Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent
of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western
Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows :—

1. All rights of way in and over such portions of the streets and <sup>Rights of way
abolished</sup>
public thoroughfares in the town of Bunbury, as are described in the
Schedule hereto, shall henceforth cease and determine, and it shall be
lawful for Her Majesty, her heirs and successors, to deal with the said
pieces of land as if they had never been public roads.

SCHEDULE

ELIOT STREET.—Between Koombana Terrace and the south-west corner of
Lot 41, containing 1 rood 8 perches, more or less.

SYMMONS STREET.—Between Koombana Terrace and the north-west corner of
Lot 79, containing 36 perches, more or less.

WATERLOO PLACE.—Between Koombana Terrace and the junction of Wellington
and Arthur Streets, containing 1 rood 2 perches, more or less.

WELLINGTON STREET.—Between Waterloo Place and the north-west corner of
Lot 217, containing 1 rood 30 perches, more or less.

Closing of Streets in Bunbury

ARTHUR STREET.—Between Waterloo Place and Prinsep Street, containing 1 rood 24 perches, more or less.

PRINSEP STREET.—Between James Street and Arthur Street, containing 3 roods 11 perches, more or less.

KOOMBANA TERRACE.—Between the south side of Clifton Street and the north boundary of Lot 262, containing 2 acres 0 roods 20 perches, more or less.
