AN ACT to amend the Public Health Act, 1886.

[Assented to, 27th October, 1896.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. THIS Act may be cited as the Public Health Act Amendment Act, 1896.

Short title

2. THE eighteenth section of the Public Health Act, 1886, is hereby amended by striking out the words "Three pence," and substituting therefor the word "Sixpence."
