# VICTORIÆ REGINÆ.

## No. XLI.

AN ACT to authorise the Construction of a Railway from Bayswater to Perth Racecourse.

[Assented to, 27th October, 1896.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

reamble.

- 1. THIS Act may be cited as the Perth Racecourse Railway Short Title. Act, 1896.
- 2. IT shall be lawful to construct and maintain a railway from Bayswater to Perth Racecourse, with all necessary, proper, and construct usual works and conveniences in connection therewith, in the line described in the Schedule to this Act.

Deviation.

3. IT shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Railways to deviate from the line as described in such Schedule to the extent of two miles on either side thereof.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.

### SCHEDULE.

#### PERTH RACECOURSE RAILWAY.

#### DESCRIPTION OF LINE OF RAILWAY.

Commencing at Bayswater Station on the Eastern Railway, 16 miles 20 chains, or thereabouts, from its commencing point at Fremantle, and proceeding thence in an Easterly direction for about 42 chains 72 links; thence in a South-Easterly direction for about 15 chains; thence in a South-Westerly direction for about 18 chains; thence in a South-Easterly direction for about 62 chains; thence in a South-Westerly direction for about 26 chains and 28 links, and terminating at a point in or near the Perth Racecourse; as more particularly delineated by red line on Map marked P.W.D., W.A., 4863, deposited as provided for by 55° Victoriæ, No. 34, Section 10. Total length about 2 miles 4 chains.
