AN ACT to authorise the Construction of a
Railway from Kalgoorlie to Menzies.

[Assented to, 27th October, 1896.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parlia-
ment assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Preamble.

1. THIS Act may be cited as the Kalgoorlie-Menzies Railway
Act, 1896.

Short Title.

2. IT shall be lawful to construct and maintain a railway from
Kalgoorlie to Menzies with all necessary, proper, and usual works
and conveniences in connection therewith, in the line described in
the Schedule to this Act.

Authority to
construct.

Deviation.

3. IT shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Railways to deviate from the line as described in such Schedule to the extent of ten miles on either side thereof.

SCHEDULE.

KALGOORLIE-MENZIES RAILWAY.

DESCRIPTION OF LINE OF RAILWAY.

Commencing at a point in or near Kalgoorlie Townsite, and proceeding thence in a generally North-North-Westerly direction for about 82 miles, and terminating at a point in or near Menzies Townsite, as more particularly delineated by a red line on Map marked P.W.D., W.A., 4906, deposited as provided for by 55° Victoriæ, No. 34, Section 10.
