AN ACT to amend the High School Act, 1876.

[Assented to, 23rd December, 1897.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. THE words "Five hundred," where they last occur in the Third Section of the High School Act, 1876, are hereby repealed, and the words "One thousand" are substituted in lieu thereof.
