AN ACT to repeal certain Export Duties.

[Assented to, 17th July, 1895.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. THIS Act may be cited as "The Export Duties Repeal Act, 1895."

Short title.

2. THE Acts specified in the Schedule to this Act are repealed to the extent in the third column of the said Schedule mentioned:

Provided that this repeal shall not affect anything duly done or suffered, or any right acquired, or obligation or liability incurred under any enactment hereby repealed; or any penalty or punishment incurred in respect of any offence committed against any

enactment hereby repealed; or any legal proceeding or remedy in respect of such right, obligation, liability, penalty or punishment; and any such proceeding may be carried on and remedy had as if this Act had not been passed.
