AN ACT to repeal the Duties on certain Articles and things.

[Assented to, 30th September, 1896.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Preamble.

1. THIS Act may be cited as the Customs Duties Repeal Act, 1896.

Short title.

2. ON and after the coming into operation of this Act the duties of Customs imposed by The Tariff Act, 1893, on the articles and things enumerated in the Schedule to this Act shall cease and determine, and the same are repealed accordingly.

Repeal.

3. THIS Act shall come into operation on the first day of October, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-six.

Commencement of Act.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
