AN ACT to amend the Bastardy Laws Act, 1875.

[Assented to, 27th October, 1896.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Bastardy Laws Act, 1875, be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Preamble.

1. THIS Act may be cited as the Bastardy Laws Act, 1875, Amendment Act, 1896.

Short Title.

2. SECTION five of the Bastardy Laws Act, 1875, is hereby amended by striking out, in the fifteenth line of the said Section, the words "Five shillings," and substituting in the place thereof the words "Twelve shillings and sixpence."
