AN ACT to further amend the Auctioneers Act, 1873.

[Assented to, 23rd December, 1897.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend the Auctioneers Act, 1873: Be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. THE short title of this Act shall be the Auctioneers Act, 1873, Further Amendment Act, 1897.

Short title.

2. THE prohibition contained in the seventh section of the Auctioneers Act, 1873, shall not apply to persons selling shares in any incorporated company.

Prohibition of night auctions not to apply to sales of shares in any incorporated company.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
