AN ACT to apply a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue to the Service of the Six Months ending the last day of June, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-three, and to appropriate the Supplies granted in this Session of Parliament.

[Assented to, 13th January, 1893.]

Most Gracious Sovereign,-

WE, Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia in Parlia-Preamble. ment assembled, towards making good the supply which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this Session of Parliament, have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sums hereinafter mentioned, and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted; And be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows (that is to say):—

Appropriation—1893.

Appropriation and application of moneys.

1. OUT of the Consolidated Revenue there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, for or towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty, a sum not exceeding Three hundred and fourteen thousand five hundred and twenty-four pounds fifteen shillings and sixpence for the service of the six months ending the last day of June, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-three, for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule hereto.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent to this Act.
