AN ACT to apply a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue to the Service of the Year ending the last day of June, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-four, and to appropriate the Supplies granted in this Session of Parliament.

[Assented to, 13th October, 1893.]

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN,—

WE, Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia in Parliament assembled, towards making good the supply which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this Session of Parliament, have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sums hereinafter mentioned, and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted; And be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows (that is to say):—

Preamble.

Application of
moneys.

1. OUT of the Consolidated Revenue there shall and may be issued and applied, for or towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty, a sum not exceeding Four hundred and eight thousand and ninety-three pounds six shillings and twopence for the service of the year ending the last day of June, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-four, for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule hereto.

2. ALL sums granted by this Act, and the Act mentioned in the First Schedule to this Act, out of the said Consolidated Revenue towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty, amounting as appears by the said Schedule in the aggregate to the sum of Five hundred and eight thousand and ninety-three pounds six shillings and twopence, are appropriated, and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act mentioned in the said First Schedule for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule hereto.
